Dear Fellow Owners,

The ban on discretionary water use imposed on June 15th has proven to be effective at curtailing the unusually high rate of water consumption. The Board and Park Management now feel more comfortable about the state of water consumption in relation to the Park's annual water use limit and have therefore determined that water restrictions can be eased somewhat.

Effective Tuesday, August 3, most discretionary water ban restrictions will be removed, however a few will remain in place for the remainder of the year. Owners are asked to read the following section carefully to ensure that they clearly understand what is permitted and what is not. Owners are also reminded that in accordance with the Park's Rules & Regulations, the watering of vegetation is to occur **prior to 8:00 am** and **after 8:00 pm**.

Permitted Activities

- Washing of RVs, patio furniture, decks, & structures using a pressure-washer
- Quick rinse-offs of furniture, structures, & pets using a hose equipped with a spray nozzle
- Watering of small plants, grass, & flowers using a hose equipped with a spray nozzle
- Watering should be limited to 15 minutes per day
- Flush outs of grey & black water holding tanks on RVs

Prohibited Activities

- Unattended watering of any kind
- Free-flow open-hose watering of trees & plants
- Watering of grass using sprinklers
- Filling of 'kiddie pools'
- Car washing
- Gravel washing

As of August 3, **Exemption Notices** related to the water ban are no longer necessary, as no prohibited activities will be approved.

Persons who choose not to comply with the remaining water restrictions should expect an introduction to the Park's new Bylaw Officer.
